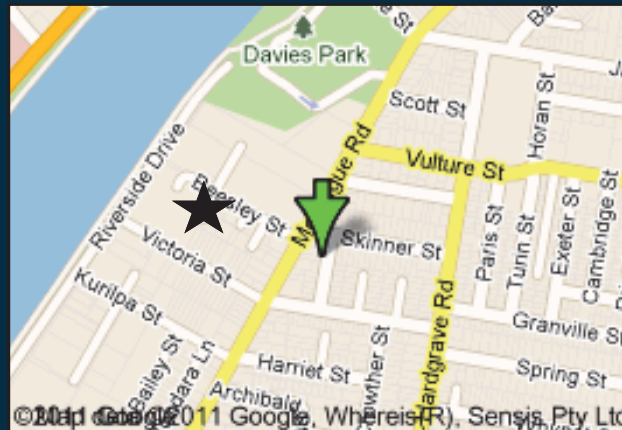

WHO IS THE CCP FOR?

The Crucial Connection Program works with, and for, young people between the ages of 12 and 18 years whose mothers are in prison and with their families.

The Crucial Connection Program also supports 17 and 18 year old women who are incarcerated.

What is CCP?

The Crucial Connection Program is a Reconnect program delivered by Sisters Inside workers in South East Queensland to provide confidential support to young women in prison and young people whose mothers are in prison.

The Crucial Connection Program also assists those young people to become more involved with their family, work, education, training and the community through mediation, counseling and practical support for the whole family.

The Crucial Connection Program works closely with other local services to provide support in a way that is sensitive to your needs and your families needs.

The Crucial Connection Program workers will listen to you and assist you to find out what works best for you and your family.

The Crucial Connection Program provides a range of support to both young people and families that are determined by their own unique circumstances. It is flexible and we can meet with you at a safe location where you feel comfortable, such as Sisters Inside, school, home or another venue in the community.

How does CCP support young people & their family?

The Crucial Connection Program can assist Young People to:

- Have regular visits with mum;
- Work things out with their family;
- Connect with programs that assist in finding employment;
- Stay in school when it gets too tough;
- Link into training options;
- Get income support if eligible; and
- Find somewhere safe to stay if necessary.

The Crucial Connection Program can assist Parents, Guardians and Families to:

- Work things out with the young person;
- Find out the best way to talk things through;
- Learn to live together when things are hard;
- Learn to live apart but stay connected.
